



BARN RULES

- 1. Smoking is prohibited in the barn, barn aisle, near bedding, hay or manure storage areas.**
- 2. Releases must be signed before anyone may handle or ride any horses. Medical Releases should be completed for riders under (18) years of age. Please visit our [Forms and Releases](#) page.**
- 3. No guests may ride or handle horses at RREC without prior permission from RREC Management.**
- 4. Helmets are mandatory while mounted. NO EXCEPTIONS. ALL riding school participants must wear an ASTM Approved helmet. It is also recommended that you wear your helmet while working in the barn area.**
- 5. Jumping is only allowed during instruction.**
- 6. The stabling area, aisles and arenas are off-limits to everyone except RREC staff members, boarders and students tacking up for the next scheduled lesson.**
- 7. Parents and visitors are welcome to observe students during their lesson by standing or sitting outside the arena(s). Parents and visitors should not enter the arena at any time.**
- 8. No dogs are allowed. RREC requests that you not bring your dog—we have plenty.**
- 9. The barn aisle and wash rack areas are to be kept free of grooming tools, equipment, hair and manure. Hoses should be coiled after use. PLEASE clean up after your horse. Please do not waste water; turn off water after use and use buckets whenever possible.**
- 10. Report any change of address, telephone number or horse status to RREC Management. If you board or lease a horse at RREC and plan to leave town, please advise Management where you can be reached and what arrangements you have made for your horse.**
- 11. Lunging & turn out: lunging is allowed in the lunging arena only. Turn out in paddocks may be allowed with prior permission from Management.**
- 12. Clinics, lessons and special events will be offered at RREC. These events will have precedence in facility use. Management will keep you informed of these activities whenever possible.**
- 13. RREC Management shall have the right to assign and re-assign paddocks and box stalls in order to minimize dangerous or nuisance situations or wear & tear on the facility.**
- 14. Please notify RREC Management of any necessary repairs, maintenance, problems, complaints or needed supplies.**
- 15. Boarding at RREC is a privilege. Actions such as stealing, use of narcotics, flagrant damage or destruction of stable property, abuse of animals, physical or verbal abuse of RREC personnel or any other actions which are deemed detrimental to RREC will not be tolerated and will result in the immediate expulsion from the premises.**
- 16. You are hereby advised that direct loss, damage or injury to your horse, tack, equipment or trailer is not covered by RREC insurance, while on these premises. You as the owner of these personal property items have the financial interest in same, therefore it is up to you to be sure that they are insured under a homeowner's, tenant's, or other insurance policy, or under a separate policy as in the case of loss, injury, damage or death of a horse.**
