MEDICATIONS POLICY

1. No prescription medication or non-prescription medication, including but not limited to aspirin, cough medicine or nose drops, may be given to a child except under the following conditions:
 - a. A signed and dated, written authorization of the parent is on file;
 - b. Prescription medication is in the original container and labeled with the child's name, name of drug, dosage, directions for administering, date and physician's name.
 - c. Non-prescription medication must be in its original packaging, labeled with the child's name and include the dosage and directions for administering.
 - d. Parent's dosage instructions may not exceed the manufacturer's recommended dosage; and
 - e. A written report including type of medication given, dosage, time, date and name of the person administering the medication shall be kept with the child's registration record.
2. Medication shall be stored in the office, out of the reach of children.
3. Medications requiring refrigeration shall be kept in the refrigerator, in the office.
